Terms & Conditions of Participation

By participating in Taste of the World, you agree to abide by these terms.

1. Participant Responsibilities

- Participants must adhere to all health and safety regulations set forth by the event organisers and local authorities.
- There will be no cooking at the venue. All dishes to be pre-prepared.
- Limited number of food warmers and induction cooktops can be provided on a first come first serve basis, to help keep food warm.
- Participants are responsible for setting up their allotted table.
- A maximum of 2 dishes per table.
- Serving portions to be maintained at tasting size, to be able to meet crowd capacity.

2. Food Safety and Hygiene

- Participants must maintain cleanliness and hygiene standards at their booths.
- All food samples must be prepared, stored, and served in compliance with local health codes.
- Participants must display proper food handling practices and ensure the safety of all food items provided to event attendees.
- Event participants must clearly label any food items that contain common allergens, such as nuts, dairy, gluten, etc.

3. Liability

- Esperance Community Arts will carry public liability insurance in relation to the event.
- Participants will be covered for personal injury by the organiser's volunteer insurance only if they have registered as a volunteer, by filling in the volunteer form.
- Participants are solely responsible for the quality and safety of the food items they provide.

4. Reimbursements

- All participants are allotted a maximum of \$300 for purchases related to the presentation.
- Participants are to NOT exceed the allotted amount and understand that anything above will not be reimbursed.
- All receipts and invoices must be submitted for reimbursements to be processed. Amount cannot be claimed without proof of purchase.
- All receipts and invoices to be sent as one email, with the completed reimbursement form.
- Amount will be processed within one week of receipt of reimbursement forms

5. General

- All participants must conduct themselves in a respectful manner towards other participants, volunteers, and other attendees. Any form of harassment, discrimination, or disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated and may result in removal from the event premises.
- By participating in Taste of the World, participants grant the event organisers permission to use their likeness, images, and branding for promotional purposes.
- Any grievance or complaints must be made in writing to the event organisers.
